



## 2017 National Jamboree Youth Code of Conduct

- I will be guided by the Scout Oath and Scout Law and will obey all U.S., local and state laws.
- I will set a good example by keeping myself neatly dressed and presentable and will wear my Jamboree credentials at all times.
- I will attend all scheduled programs and participate as required in cooperation with other unit members and leaders.
- I will be responsible for keeping the hotel room and my tent clean and neat and will follow the bedtime and sleep schedule of the unit.
- I understand that all participants may only bring items specified on the equipment list provided by the Boy Scouts of America Jamboree Committee and will label all personal gear and keeping them clean and neat.
- I understand I must have a current photo ID in my possession at all times.
- I understand that I can bring and use a cellular/smart phone while on tour and at the Jamboree to communicate with family, troop members, adult leaders and for emergencies. Listening to music on the tour bus is allowed as long as earphones are used and not during tour history reports or leader instruction. The phone is not to be used for playing games or watching videos.
- I understand that laptops, tablets, or gaming devices are not allowed.
- I understand that the possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs is prohibited.
- I understand that serious and/or repetitive behavior violations, including cheating, stealing, dishonesty, fighting, and cursing may result in serious disciplinary action and loss of privileges or expulsion from the Jamboree
- I understand that gambling of any form, possession of lasers of any type, fireworks, firearms and weapons are prohibited.
- I understand that hazing has no place in Scouting nor do gauntlets, belt lines and similar acts of physical punishments.
- I will demonstrate respect for unit and Jamboree property and be personally responsible for any loss, breakage or vandalism of property as a result of my actions.
- Neither the unit leaders nor the Boy Scouts of America will be responsible for loss, breakage or theft of personnel items. I will check items of value at the direction of the unit leaders. Theft will be grounds for expulsion.
- I will obey the safety rules and instructions of all supervisors and staff members.
- I will adhere to all Jamboree recycling policies and regulations. I will also not litter.

**Violation of this Code of Conduct, or any other conduct deemed to be inconsistent with the values of Scouting, may result in expulsion from the Jamboree at the participant's own expense and could result in revocation of Boy Scouts of America membership.**
